Friday Crafternoon - Fridays between 3 and 4 pm - Drop in and try our school aged craft in the children's area.

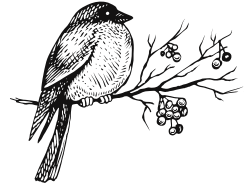

Card for a Veteran - All day, between November 1st and 7th - Drop in and fill in a postcard that we will send to a veteran on your behalf. All ages!

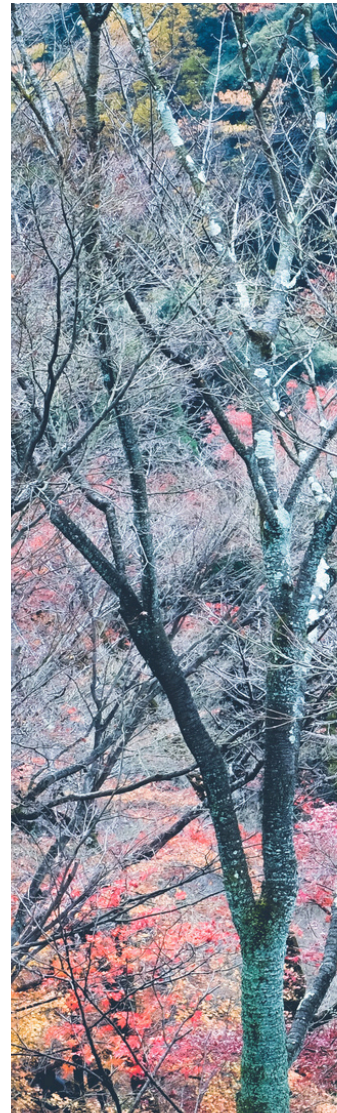
